- 1. HAIG HAS TELEPHONED ME FOLLOWING HIS SPEECH AT THE OAS WHICH HE SAID WENT DOWN LIKE A LEAD BALLOON. NOBODY THERE WAS LIKELY AGAIN TO CALL HIM EVEN-HANDED.
- 2. HE HAD SPOKEN TO COSTA MENDEZ AND TOLD HIM THAT TIME HAD RUN OUT. THE ONLY WAY TO AVOID AN IMMEDIATE CONFLICT WOULD BE FOR HIM TO MEET WITHOUT DELAY WITH THE JUNTA. 3. HAIG SAID THAT HE WOULD BE PRESENTING HIS PROPOSALS TO THE ARGENTINIANS ON A TAKE IT OR LEAVE IT BASIS. THEY WOULD HAVE 24 HOURS IN WHICH TO ANSWER YES OR NO. HE WOULD EMPHASISE THE QUOTE TERRIBLE CONSEQUENCES UNQUOTE THE ARGENTINIANS WOULD SUFFER IF THEY DID NOT RESPOND FAVOURABLY.
