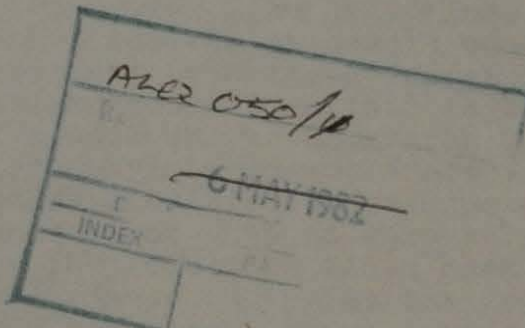

OPERATION CORPORATEITEM 1. THE ARGENTINE AIRCRAFT CARRIER

1. The Committee had before them a revised paper (1) prepared in accordance with their instructions (2) at their meeting earlier that day.
2. Summing up a short discussion, Sir TERENCE LEWIN said they would wish to invite the Defence Secretariat to amend the paper in the light of their discussion, and then forward it to the Cabinet Office for consideration by OD(SA).

ITEM 2. FALKLAND ISLANDS LANDING OPERATIONS - REINFORCEMENTS

3. The Committee had before them a draft OD(SA) paper (3) which had been revised in accordance with their instructions (4) at their meeting earlier that day.
4. Summing up a detailed discussion on the paper, Sir TERENCE LEWIN said they would wish to instruct the Assistant Chief of the Defence Staff (Policy) to revise the paper incorporating the amendments they had agreed and the views they had expressed in discussion, and present it again for their consideration at their meeting the next day.
