

You asked me this morning if I could let you have a list of those who would be attending the lunch at Chequers on Sunday 2nd May, to be followed by a meeting of OD(SA).

2. In addition to the Prime Minister the other members of OD(SA) will be present, the Home Secretary, ~~the Foreign and Commonwealth Secretary~~, the Secretary of State for Defence and the Chancellor of the Duchy and the Paymaster General. The regular attenders of OD(SA) and a restricted secretariat will also be there: the Chief of the Defence Staff, Sir Antony Acland, Sir Michael Palliser, Sir Robert Armstrong, Mr Wade-Gery and Brigadier Eyre.
