  - c. Arrival of RAF Harriers direct to the Task Force.
  - d. Failure of the UN Secretary General to secure a ceasefire.
  - e. The non-aligned nations meeting in Havana.
  - f. Argentinian (Villas) in semi-finals of French championships.
  - g. Weather.

  - c. The political situation.

Information has been received that "Noticias Argentinas" in Buenos Aires published an article on 1 June about Radio Atlantico del Sur in which it described the station as containing "folk music and commentaries on the South Atlantic War". It particularly mentioned the lists of wounded prisoners given out nightly by RA del S.
4. Unfortunately due to a BBC transmitter failure, 7 minutes of this morning's broadcast (No 22) were lost.

No reports have been received about interference in the target area.
