

  - g. Final talks between the Soviets and Head of the Argentine Grain Board.

- 2. The following were the principal features:
  - a. Military situation.
  - b. Political situation.
  - c. List of wounded prisoners.
  - d. A question and answer feature about the Geneva Convention.
  - e. Argentine propaganda (based on an article in the Financial Times).
  - f. Senor Costa Mendes at the Non-Aligned Nations meeting in Havana.
  - g. Two features based on articles from Spanish magazines, one relating an interview with an Argentine soldier captured on South Georgia and the other from YA magazine about Britain's successful decolonisation policies.

### Reception

3. The pattern of jamming now a pears to have been established with the morning broadcast relatively free and maximum effort being made during the evening show.
