NEWS

1. The main items included in both broadcasts were:
 - a. The Prime Minister's interview with NBC TV.
 - b. French diplomatic support for the UK.
 - c. The conflict in the Lebanon.
 - d. Continuing British land operations around Port Stanley.
 - e. The bombing of the Liberian supertanker.
 - f. Arms reduction proposals by the US President.
 - g. Follow-up on the shooting of the Israeli ambassador.
 - h. Industrial dispute at the Bilbao football stadium.

FEATURES

2. The principal features were:
 - a. Political situation.
 - b. Military situation (as a conversation piece).
 - c. Update on the political prisoners in Argentina.
 - d. Operations by 1/7 GR in LAFONIA.
 - e. News from Buenos Aires (now that Argentine papers are arriving regularly and within 36 hours, it is intended that this will become a regular feature).
 - f. World Cup round-up.
 - g. World Press review.
 - h. Junta's propaganda based on an article in the Times.

FEEDBACK/RECEPTION

3. Signal strength continues as previously reported although there is some evidence that jamming of the evening broadcast may have been stepped up during the first half of the programme.
