## Anglo-Italian Summit

I regret that, owing to my absence last week, you have not had an earlier reply to your letter of 3 June.

The Prime Minister has considered the possibility of either travelling to Rome on 6 July or returning to London on 8 July, but has concluded that, in the light of her other engagements, she will need to confine her visit to 7 July. On 6 July, as you mention, the Prime Minister has an Audience with The Queen, and is also answering Questions in the House of Commons. On 8 July there is a meeting of the Cabinet, and the Prime Minister will again be answering Questions in the House. She would therefore be grateful if a programme could be arranged which allowed her to leave and return to London on 7 July.

Mrs. Thatcher would be grateful if the Chancellor of the Exchequer, in addition to the Foreign and Commonwealth Secretary, could accompany her.

I am sending copies of this letter to John Kerr (HM Treasury), John Rhodes (Department of Trade), Jonathan Spencer (Department of Industry), and to David Wright (Cabinet Office).
