LETTER DATED 9 MAY 1982 FROM THE PERMANENT REPRESENTATIVE OF  
ARGENTINA TO THE UNITED NATIONS ADDRESSED TO THE PRESIDENT  
OF THE SECURITY COUNCIL

I have the honour to inform you that at 01.40 hours Argentine time the British forces started a simultaneous attack on Puerto Argentino and Puerto Darwin which lasted for 35 minutes. Puerto Argentino was fired upon by two ships located at approximately 20 kilometres from the coast. The operation against Puerto Darwin was carried out by five helicopters equipped with missiles and 30 mm guns.

According to the information available as of 05.40 hours Argentine time, the enemy fleet has been active since 03.00 hours. Argentina has made reconnaissance flights which the British Harrier planes tried unsuccessfully to intercept.

This latest British attack in violation of the Charter of the United Nations and Security Council resolution 502 (1982), is taking place at a time when the Secretary-General is taking steps with the Governments of the Republic of Argentina and of the United Kingdom to reach a peaceful settlement of the conflict.

I should be grateful if you would have this letter circulated as a Security Council document as a matter of urgency.
